



Housing Assistance Program Home Rehabilitation

Basic Program Info



Partners' HOME Rehabilitation & Accessibility Program assists qualified homeowners with the financing and coordination of critical home repairs to ensure that their home is a safe, decent, sanitary and accessible place to live.

Financial assistance through Partners Housing Program is provided as a 0% interest, deferred loan. Partners' loans are secured through property liens and require no monthly payment. Loans are repaid to Partners when the home is sold or no longer the borrowers' primary residence.

Qualification

To qualify a household must ...

- Demonstrate a need for assistance
- Own and occupy a single-family home.
- Property must be covered by a homeowner's insurance policy.
- Property must be located in Sheboygan, Manitowoc, Kewaunee, Door, or Calumet County
- Property value must not exceed federal limits for assistance (see below)
- Gross household income must be less than 80% of the County Median Income (see below)
