GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES: The Intake Specialist will support our energy assistance and weatherization programs; guiding clients through the application process, verifying eligibility, managing documentation, and assisting in outreach efforts across our service areas.

- Manage customer intake in-person and by phone.
- Answer questions, process applications, and verify eligibility documentation
- Maintain accurate client records and comply with all program guidelines
- Refer qualified clients to the appropriate assistance program
- Provide alternative resource information to ineligible applicants
- Conduct outreach in coordination with outreach staff
- Attend community events and promote program awareness
- Participate in after-hours on-call rotation during the emergency heating season
- Travel to other office locations or events as needed
- Keep current on policy updates and maintain program compliance
- Protect client confidentiality at all times
